ASSOCIATE JUDGE NAMED TO THE 19TH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT

Chief Judge Jay W. Ukena was notified on March 20, 2019, by Marcia M. Meis, Director of the Administrative Office of Illinois Courts, that Mr. Bolling "Bodie" W. Haxall, III. of Barrington received the majority number of votes cast and is eligible for appointment to serve as an Associate Judge in Lake County. Haxall will fill the vacancy created by the retirement of Associate Judge John J. Scully.

"Mr. Haxall will bring a strong work ethic, great intellect and humility to his new role as an associate judge for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit. We look forward to Bodie joining us," said Chief Judge Ukena.

Mr. Haxall received his Bachelor of Arts in Government and History from Wesleyan University in 1995. In 1999, he earned his Juris Doctor from the University of Chicago Law School and was then admitted to practice law in Illinois. He is a current member of several bar associations including: the Illinois State Bar Association, the Lake County Bar Association, the Chicago Bar Association, the Illinois Capital Litigation Trial Bar, and the Jefferson Inns of Court. Mr. Haxall is an Assistant US Attorney at The United States Attorney's Office where he is engaged in criminal prosecution. As a result of the Lake County Bar Association poll, Mr. Haxall received the distinction of being "highly recommended" by its members.
