Trial by jury is an essential part of every American's right as guaranteed by state and federal constitutions. According to Chief Judge Jay W. Ukena, "Jurors are the backbone of our court system, and this is a week to honor the citizens of Lake County who have performed their civic duty."

Plans for Juror Appreciation Week include:

- A resolution proclaiming Juror Appreciation Week by the Lake County Board
- A welcome given by Chief Judge Jay W. Ukena to summoned jurors
- Public service announcements in the media thanking jurors for their service
- Light refreshments offered as a "thank you" to those who are serving

In Lake County, jurors are selected from lists of licensed drivers and registered voters. Approximately 8,500 residents of Lake County report each year for jury service. The right to a jury trial is ensured by the Sixth and Seventh Amendments of the United States Constitution, and by Article 1, Section 13 of the Illinois Constitution.
