Student's home address and telephone number

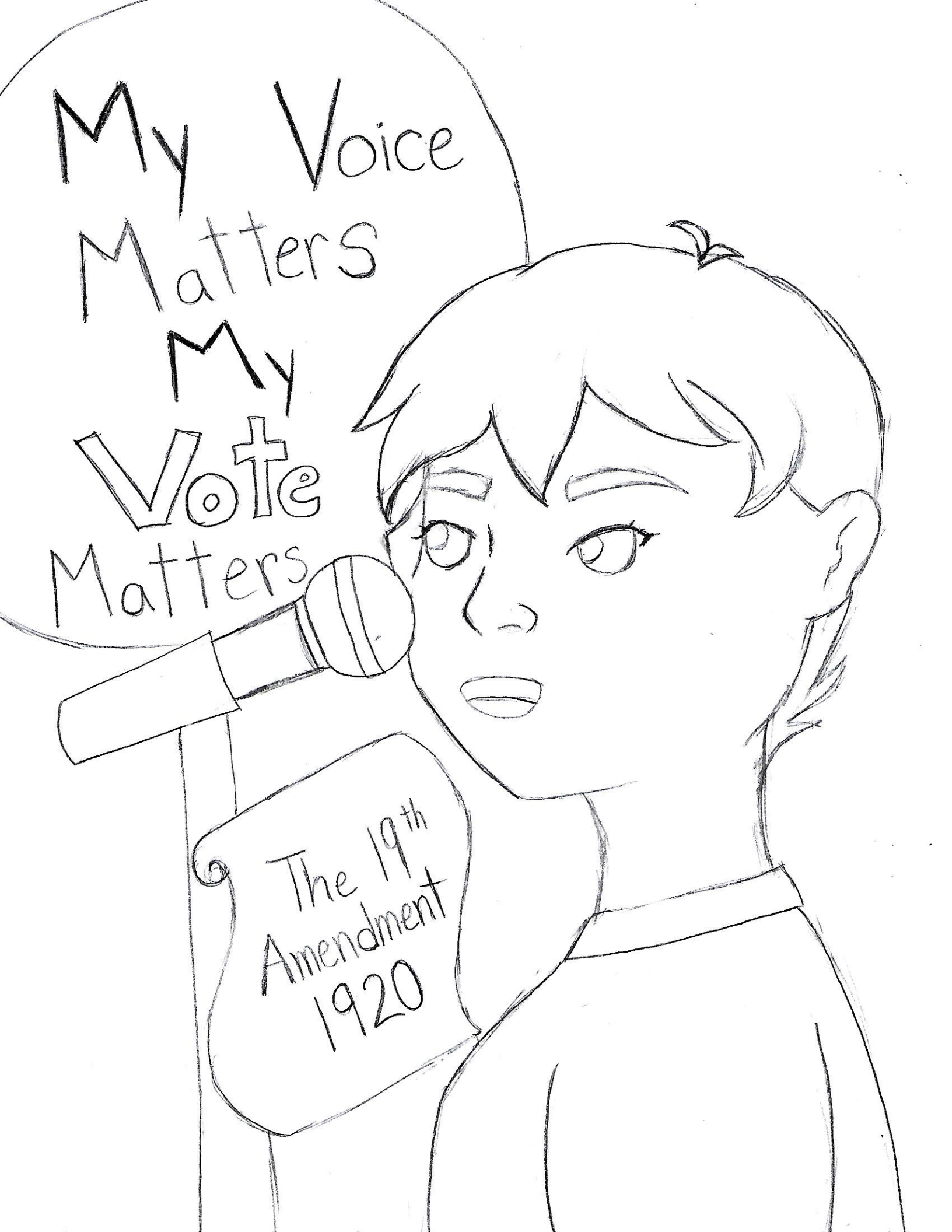
7. First, Second and Third Place winners will be selected from each grade level.

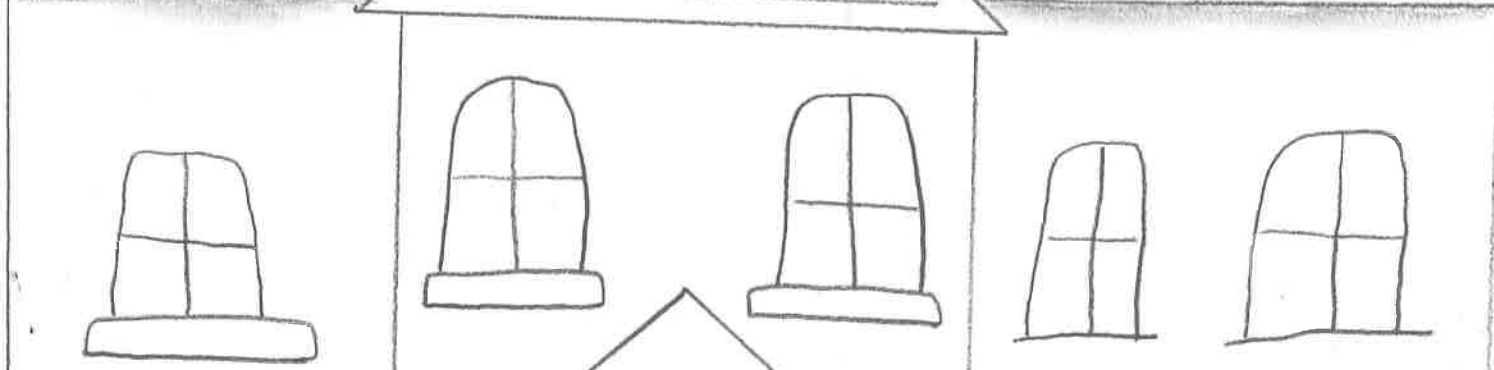
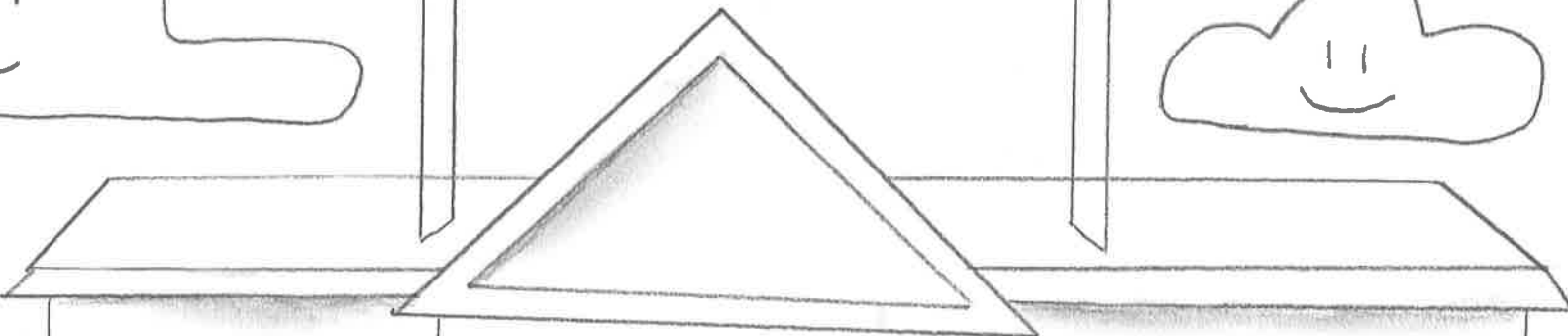
