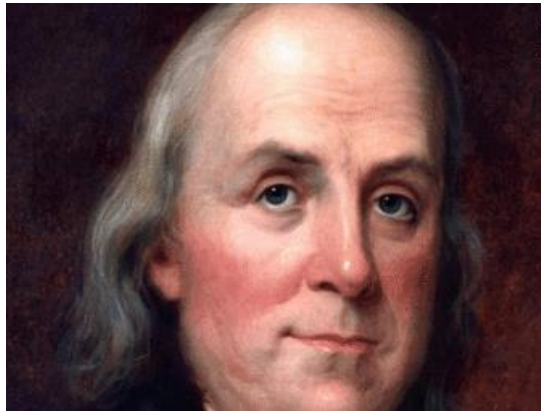


# Why Is “Freedom of Speech” Important?

2. It Lets Us Tell Others How We Feel About Something

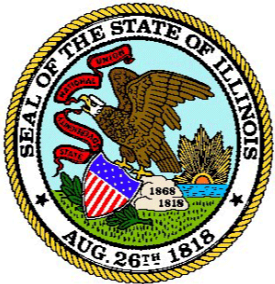
