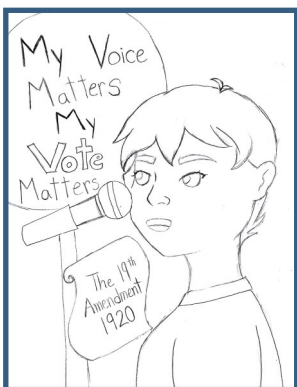


Law Day 2023 Illustration Contest

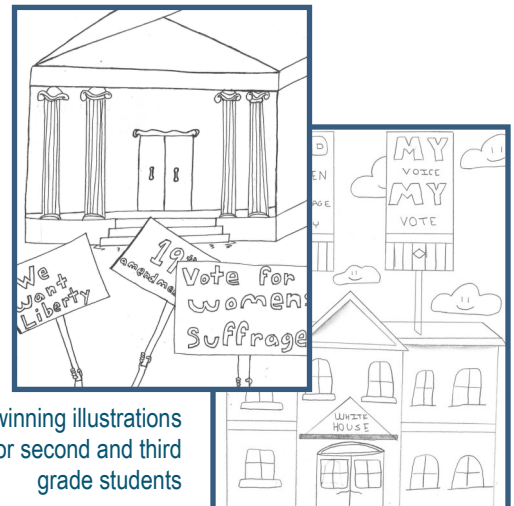
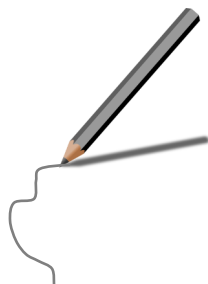
