

C-205 Standing Order for Submission of Proposed Court Orders, Paper Courtesy Copies, and Requesting an Interpreter:

Orders:

All proposed Court orders must be submitted through the eCourt Portal with the following exceptions:

- a) If the attorneys, after in-person or telephonic consultation in a good faith effort to resolve any disagreement, cannot agree upon the language of a proposed order, then the attorneys may submit ONE draft order in Word format “track changes” mode that has been redlined to reflect the specific language that is in dispute and the proposed language each party favors via email to: CC205@lakecountyil.gov.
- b) Dismissal Orders can be submitted through the eCourt Portal at any time.
- c) At the Court’s specific direction.

Courtesy Copies:

Paper courtesy copies of all contested motions shall be submitted to the Court at least 5 business days in advance of hearing, in accordance with Local Rule 2-1.02. It is the movant’s responsibility to provide the paper courtesy copies, and the courtesy copies shall include a copy of the pleading being attacked by the motion.

Requesting an Interpreter:

If a party is requesting an interpreter for a witness or a party, such request(s) shall be made in writing at least 14 days prior to the scheduled hearing. This order also applies to sign language interpreters and hearing impaired witnesses and parties.
